The Nuova Compagnia di Canto Popolare (literally "New Company of Folk Song"), also known by the acronym NCCP, is an Italian folk group, founded in Naples in 1969.

== History ==

The musical project was founded by musicians Eugenio Bennato, Carlo D’Angiò, and Giovanni Mauriello with the aim of research and spread ancient traditional music from Campania and more generally from South Italy. Thanks to the encounter with the ethnomusicologist Roberto De Simone, the group eventually focused their research on Neapolitan vocal genres from the 15th and 16th centuries such as tammuriate, fronne, and serenate.

The LP World Tour 2009 was the fifth concert tour by Italian singer Laura Pausini, starting in Brescia on 28 February 2009 and ending in Milan on 23 December 2009. This tour was in support of Pausini's album Primavera in anticipo / Primavera anticipada which was released in 2008.

It reached Europe and the Americas. It was the longest world tour made by Pausini in her career so far.

== Background ==

During 2008, the singer announced about touring a whole year during 2009 from February to December, which gives her performances in Italy, Europe and the Americas. The tour took place in important cities like Madrid, Barcelona, Paris, Zürich, Geneva, Helsinki, Turku, Stockholm, Brussels and others. Then, made a few stops on North American cities, such as Dominican Republic, United States, Canada and Mexico; continues to South America reaching Argentina, Chile, Peru and Brasil.

To conclude the tour, she returned to Italy and performed during November–December and finally end the promotion. Due to the massive sold-out shows and tickets demand for the tour, the World Tour 2009 took place in Milan during six nights, five in Rome; the shows in Turin and Florence were triplicated while in Bologna...

Il canto dei Sanfedisti

== History ==

The lyrics of the song exalt the Catholic faith and the monarchy, opposing the atheism and anti-clericalism of the French revolutionaries. The melody has been attributed to Neapolitan musician Giuseppe Giordani. The attribution of "Il canto dei Sanfedisti" to Giordani stems from the testimony of Luigi Picchianti, a 19th-century Florentine music critic and historian. In a 1866

article published in the journal Archivio Storico Italiano, he wrote that Giordani composed the song's music during the repression of the Neapolitan Republic by Sanfedisti troops. However, some recent sources have debated the accuracy of this attribution; no contemporary documents exist to confirm Giordani's authorship. The song's lyrics were written by various unidentified authors and later adapted to Giordani's melody.

"Il canto dei Sanfedisti" was sung during the battles fought by the Sanfedisti against Napoleonic and revolutionary forces, becoming a symbol of resistance...

The Teatro del Silenzio (English: Theater of Silence) is an open air amphitheater located in the city of Lajatico – the hometown of Andrea Bocelli – in the Tuscany region of Italy. In 2006, Bocelli convinced the municipality of Lajatico to build this outdoor venue whose structure utilizes the natural formations of the hilly landscape. Bocelli contributed greatly to its construction.

Bocelli, the honorary president of the theater, performs an annual concert there every July; the theater is silent for the rest of the year.

The Inedito World Tour was the sixth world tour by Italian singer Laura Pausini, in support of her eleventh studio album, *Inedito / Inédito*. It was planned to visit America, Europe, and Australia but ended on 15 September 2012, after Pausini announced she was pregnant. Due to the announcement, the tour was cut short, and plans for a second American leg, a second European leg, and the tour's debut in Australia were cancelled.

== Background information ==

On 30 December 2010, Pausini announced her eleventh studio album, *Inedito / Inédito*, which was set to be released in both Italian and Spanish on 11 November 2011. The title and tracklist of the album were revealed on Pausini's website on 10 September 2011. The first single from the album, "Benvenuto" / "Bienvenido," was released on 12 September 2011. The album was

released on 11 November 2011, after which Pausini embarked on her sixth world tour, starting in Italy during the last two weeks of December. The tour then continued in South America and Europe during the first half of 2012, with plans to return to South America later in 2012.

Vivere Live in Tuscany is a live album and DVD of a pop concert by classical Italian tenor Andrea Bocelli. The concert was performed at Bocelli's Teatro del Silenzio in Lajatico, Tuscany, July 2007. In this DVD he performs duets with Sarah Brightman, Elisa, Laura Pausini and Heather Headley, and collaborates with Chris Botti, Lang Lang and Kenny G. It was certified Triple Diamond in Brazil, by the ABPD, with over 375,000 copies sold in the country.

Io canto 2 and Yo canto 2 (English: I sing 2) are the sixteenth studio albums by Italian singer Laura Pausini. The Italian-language edition was released on February 6, 2026, while the Spanish-language edition was released on March 13, 2026, by Warner Music.

== Background ==

In September 2025, Pausini publicly announced that she was working on a new cover album, twenty years after the 2006 studio album Io canto, with which she won the Latin Grammy Award for Best Female Pop Vocal Album with the Spanish version.

On October 21, 2025, Pausini revealed the cover of the new albums on her social media profiles, both of which feature the same font used for the first cover album, Io canto. On December 16, 2025, she announced the release date of Io canto 2, released February 6, 2026, and Yo canto 2 scheduled for March 13, 2026, making known the tracklist and the available versions. On January 22, 2026, the duets of the tracklist in Italian were announced, followed by the duets of the tracklist in Spanish on February 10, 2026.

The Greatest Hits World Tour

The Greatest Hits World Tour is the seventh concert world tour by Italian singer Laura Pausini, in promotion of her compilation album 20 - The Greatest Hits that was released on 12 November 2013. The tour began with a show in Pesaro, Italy on 5 December 2013 and ended on 7 August 2015 in Marbella, Spain. In Spanish-speaking countries, the tour was renamed "Grandes Exitos Gira Mundial".

In February 2014, Pausini confirmed on her official site that the tour would be extended and that more shows would be scheduled after the 20 originally planned. This new set of concerts included two performances in Australia and one performance in Russia, marking the first time Pausini performs in such countries.

On 10 June 2014, Pausini postponed her two Australian shows and two Russian 'due to unforeseen technical problems and production issues'. The Melbourne concert scheduled for 12 June 2014 at Rod Laver Arena would now take place on 13 February 2015 at a smaller venue, Margaret Court Arena. The 14 June, Sydney show was announced for 14 February 2015. The show in St. Petersburg, Russia on 24 June 2014 was cancelled; and the show in Moscow scheduled for 27 June 2014, was rescheduled to 17 February...

Giuseppa Gaetana "Giusy" Ferreri (Italian pronunciation: [ˈdʒuːzi ferˈrɛːri]; born 17 April 1979) is an Italian singer and songwriter. In 2008, she took part in the first Italian edition of the talent show X Factor, coming in second place.

She topped the Italian Singles Chart 5 times, with the singles "Non ti scordar mai di me", "Novembre", diamond certified collaboration "Roma-Bangkok" with Baby K, "Amore e capoeira" and "Jambo", both with Takagi & Ketra. She spent a total of 48 weeks at number one in the country, beating the previous record owned by Madonna (38 weeks).

Ferreri has sold over 2.8 million copies worldwide to-date.

She has collaborated with many notable Italian singers, including Ornella Vanoni, Claudio Baglioni, Ron, Tiziano Ferro, J-Ax, Eral Mes and Giuliano Sangiorgi.

== Career ==

In June 2008, Sony BMG Italy released the debut EP by Ferreri, which includes her first single "Non ti scordar mai di me" written by Italian pop singer Tiziano Ferro, and five covers of classic songs from the 1960s and 1970s. The single held the number one position of the Italian singles chart for fifteen consecutive weeks, becoming one of the most successful tracks ever on that chart...

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
