Ro.Go.Pa.G. (also known as "RoGoPaG") is a 1963 film consisting of four segments, each written and directed by a different director. These include the French director Jean-Luc Godard (segment "Il nuovo mondo") and the Italian directors Ugo Gregoretti (segment "Il pollo ruspante"), Pier Paolo Pasolini (segment "La ricotta") and Roberto Rossellini (segment "Il libatezza").

The movie title is an abbreviation of the authors' last names: Rossellini, Godard, Pasolini, Gregoretti.

Cacciatore (lit. 'hunter') or cacciatora is an Italian dish prepared with onions, herbs, usually tomatoes, often peppers, and sometimes wine.

Cacciatore is popularly made with braised chicken (pollo alla cacciatora) or rabbit (coniglio alla cacciatora), abbacchio (abbacchio alla cacciatora), an Italian preparation of lamb, capon (cappone alla cacciatora) or potatoes (patate alla cacciatora). Preparations vary by region. In southern Italy for example, cacciatore often includes red wine, while in northern Italy, it typically includes white wine. Some versions of the dish use mushrooms.

In abbacchio alla cacciatora, pieces of abbacchio are browned in lard and then cooked for almost an hour with garlic, sage, rosemary, and salted anchovy paste. This recipe, typical of Roman cuisine, is prepared throughout Italy. It is consumed throughout central Italy year round, especially for Sunday Lunch, and is eaten as an Easter and Christmas dish.

The Valdarnese, also referred to as Valdarnese Bianca, Valdarno Bianca or Pollo del Valdarno, is a breed of large white chicken from the upper Valdarno, the valley of the Arno river, in Tuscany in central Italy. It became virtually extinct in the twentieth century, but the population is recovering. It is a different breed from the Valdarno Nero, which originates in the lower part of the Valdarno, and is black.

== History ==

The Valdarnese takes its name from the Valdarno, the valley of the Arno river. It was in the past extensively raised in the upper part of the Arno valley which runs south-east from Florence towards Arezzo, in the comuni of Montevarchi, San Giovanni Valdarno and Terranuova Bracciolini in the heart of the valley, and neighbouring comuni including Bucine, Castelfranco di Sopra, Caviglia, Figline Valdarno, Laterina, Loro Ciuffenna and Pergine Valdarno.

The first description of the white chickens of the Valdarno is that of Giuseppe Licciardelli in 1899. Luigi Pochini (1900, 1905) recommends the Valdarno breed above

all others as suitable for both small- and large-scale rearing, for its rapid growth and the maternal instinct of the hens, but notes that it requires space...
