Familiar

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In European folklore of the medieval and early modern periods, familiars (strictly familiar spirits, as "familiar" also meant just "close friend" or companion, and may be seen in the scientific name for dog, *Canis familiaris*) were believed to be supernatural entities, interdimensional beings, or spiritual guardians that would protect or assist witches and cunning folk in their practice of magic, divination, and spiritual insight. According to records of the time, those alleging to have had contact with familiar spirits reported that they could manifest as numerous forms, usually as an animal, but sometimes as a human or humanoid figure, and were described as "clearly defined, three-dimensional... forms, vivid with colour and animated with movement and sound", as opposed to descriptions of ghosts with their "smoky, undefined form[s]".

When they served witches, they were often thought to be malevolent, but when working for cunning folk, they were often considered benevolent (although there was some ambiguity in both cases). The Strange Familiar

Familiar Songs is an album released on Reprise Records in 1972 by American singer-songwriter Tom Rapp, the leader of folk-rock group Pearls Before Swine. It was presented as his first solo album, although several previous albums credited to Pearls Before Swine had actually been recorded by Rapp with session musicians, rather than by a working group. The album is also sometimes known simply as Tom Rapp, because its title does not appear on the front sleeve.

The album was released by Reprise without Rapp's approval or knowledge. According to Rapp, Reprise wanted to issue an album of the best songs from his Pearls Before Swine recordings, and he went

into Brooks Arthur's 914 Studios in New York City, with musicians Robbie Merkin (piano), David Wolfert (guitar) and Morrie Brown (bass), to work up ideas for re-recording some of the songs in a new way. Although some of the ideas succeeded, he felt that others needed more work, and the album was put on hold. However, his manager, who (rather than Rapp himself) held the contract with Reprise, passed the tapes to the record company, and later disappeared. Rapp only discovered that the record had been issued when he came upon it in a record...

Beautiful music

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Beautiful music (sometimes abbreviated as BM, B/EZ or BM/EZ for "beautiful music/easy listening") is a mostly instrumental music format that was prominent in North American radio from the late 1950s through the 1980s. Easy listening, elevator music, light music, mood music, and Muzak are other terms that overlap with this format and the style of music that it featured. Beautiful music can also be regarded as a subset of the middle of the road radio format.

== History ==

Beautiful music initially offered soft and unobtrusive instrumental selections on a very structured schedule with limited advertising interruptions. It often functioned as a free background music service for stores, with commercial breaks consisting only of announcements aimed at shoppers already in the stores. This practice was known as "storecasting" and was very common on the FM dial in the 1940s and 1950s.

Many of these FM stations usually simulcast their AM station and used a subcarrier (see also Subsidiary Communications Authority) to transmit a secondary signal to a store receiver by subscription. The signal was usually a slow-moving audio tape of "background music" or Muzak-type service, which was independent...

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== Format ==

The first season ran from April 14, 2013 to June 30, 2013 and consisted of twelve live shows where ten celebrity contestants impersonated various Greek and foreign singers. The contestants are evaluated by the show's judges, the audience and the other contestants. The contestant who gathers the highest score in each live (winner of the night), is able to donate the money that is collected from the audience's voting to a charity of their choice. In Cyprus, the money were given to "Mana" (Mother) organization every week.

During the live shows, no one is eliminated at the end of the night. At the end of the semi-final, the four couples with the highest cumulative scores from all eleven lives are the ones who can compete at the final for the first place. The four finalists are scored only by the audience in the final and the contestant who receives the most votes is the winner of the show. Audience is able to vote during the whole week for the winner.

Your Face Sounds Familiar (Philippine TV series) season 3

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The third season of Your Face Sounds Familiar premiered on the Kapamilya Channel on February 20, 2021. The season is the first to air outside ABS-CBN after the network's shutdown and franchise denial in 2020. The season was presented by debuting host Luis Manzano while the jury was composed of Sharon Cuneta, Gary Valenciano, and Ogie Alcasid. Taped during the COVID-19 pandemic in the Philippines, the season was filmed without a live audience and was subject to a number of health and safety protocols.

Klarisse de Guzman was named as the winner at the season finale held on May 30, 2021, attaining a total combined score of 90%. This season was also the first to implement the scoring system used in

the finales of the Kids editions.

The Most Beautiful Boy in the World

What Makes You Beautiful

"What Makes You Beautiful" (often abbreviated as WMYB) is the debut single by the British-Irish boy band One Direction. It was the lead single from their debut album, Up All Night (2011). Written by Savan Kotecha and producer Rami Yacoub, the song was released by Syco Records on 11 September 2011. The uptempo power pop track features a prominent guitar-based chorus and riff. The middle eight consists of a "na na na" hook.

"What Makes You Beautiful" was a commercial success, reaching number one in several countries. It has been certified quadruple platinum in the US with sales of 4.8 million copies as of June 2016. The single peaked at number four on the US Billboard Hot 100 and number one on the UK Singles Chart. The song won the 2012 Brit Award for British Single of the Year and was generally complimented by contemporary music critics, who highlighted the appeal to the teenage audience and the pop sensibility. It debuted at number one on the UK Singles Chart after setting a Sony Music Entertainment pre-order record and selling 153,965 copies in its first week. The single topped the Irish and Scottish Singles Charts, and reached the top ten on the Australian and New Zealand Singles...

Mystic Familiar is the fifth studio album by the American electronic musician Dan Deacon.

== Background ==

Mystic Familiar marked Dan Deacon's first solo studio record since 2015's Gliss Riffer. In the intervening years, Deacon had toured heavily and focused on other collaborative projects such as the 2017 ballet The Times Are Racing with New York City Ballet resident choreographer Justin Peck, a 2019 performance with the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra, and scoring feature films such as Theo Anthony's Rat Film and Finlay Pretsell's Time Trial. Deacon also produced and co-wrote the 2018 album Riddles by Ed Schrader's Music Beat.

In addition to finding new inspiration in these collaborative projects, during the recording of Mystic Familiar Deacon had begun regular practices of meditation and therapy, and began to use the Oblique Strategies cards created by Brian Eno and Peter Schmidt as creative prompts. Deacon has also cited David Lynch and his book Catching the Big Fish as an inspiration on the writing and recording of Mystic Familiar.

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
